

Meadows Golf Club Medical Golf Cart Flag Policy



Medical Flag Rules & Regulations

The use of a medical flag is a privilege. To obtain the privileges of using a Meadows Golf Club medical flag, golfers need to present a state certified handicap parking permit.

The Meadows Golf Club Superintendent has sole discretion over the use of medical flags, will decide if medical flags will be allowed on the golf course and if any special rules need to be applied that day due to golf course conditions. Golfers will be expected to abide by all verbal instructions provided by the professional staff.

Cart Procedures:

- Carts may leave the cart path when necessary to go to your golf ball only. Golfers will utilize the "90 degree" rule and must avoid all casual water and wet areas that cart's may cause damage to. After hitting, the golf cart must return in a straight line to the cart path.
- Medical flag privileges follow the golfer, not the cart. If two golfers are sharing a cart and one has a medical flag privilege, all announced and posted restrictions must be followed when the non-privileged golfer is driving to their ball.
- Carts may travel in rough and fairways but **MUST maintain a 15 yard distance from greens, and a 10 yard distance from tees and bunkers in all directions** unless driving on the cart path.
- **Carts must stay on the path around all greens & tees and on all Par-3's.** Carts may not be driven through any "*Ground Under Repair,*" *roped* off or similarly marked areas.
- If two golfers in the same group have medical flag privileges, they **MUST** ride together and eliminate the need for an extra golf cart leaving the cart path.
- Any use of carts off the cart path is at the golfer's own risk, and any problems or injuries resulting from such use are the golfer's responsibility. For safety reasons, the use of the golf cart on slopes is prohibited.
- Carts must follow all directional signs and may not be driven on any slopes.

Abuse of the above policy will result in the golfer being removed from the golf course.
